## Comments:

### Windows:

- Foxit: runs calc.exe at the document opening without any user confirmation message (!)
- Acrobat Reader \*:
  1. popup proposing to open "calc.exe" (warning)
  2. starts "calc.exe"

### Mac:

- Preview does not support PDF keyword /Launch
- Acrobat Reader 8.1.2: starts Calculator.app

### Linux:

- ! Assumes xcalc is in /usr/bin/xcalc
- poppler: does not support PDF keyword /Launch
- Acrobat Reader 7:
  1. popup telling it can not open "xcalc" (dumb reasons)
  2. popup proposing to open "xcalc" (warning)
  3. starts "xcalc"
- Acrobat Reader 8.1.2: based on xdg-open
  - if you are running KDE, Gnome or xfce, xcalc is started after a popup
  - otherwise, your browser is started and tries to download "xcalc"

### Note:

For Linux and Mac, no argument can be given to the command...
